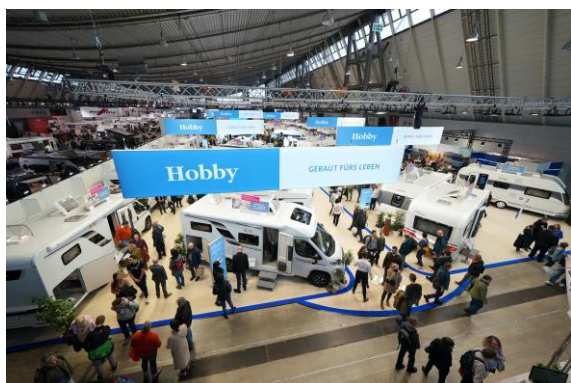


Presentation of the "Caravan of the Year" award to the ONTOUR model range
